



NOMINATION FOR THE GERIATRICIAN AND GERONTOLOGIST OF THE YEAR 2021

The Arizona Geriatrics Society honors outstanding health care professionals on an annual basis who are dedicated to the care of older adults. Nominees have made significant contributions in the field of geriatric medicine or gerontology and can be in any or all aspects of clinical care, teaching, research, policy, or innovation. Nominations can be submitted only by AZGS Members, but membership is not required for the nominee.

- The Geriatrician of the Year Award is open to all Arizona licensed providers including physicians, nurse practitioners, physician assistants, pharmacists, and dentists.
- The Gerontologist of the Year Award is open to all Arizona allied health care professionals including psychologists, nurses, social workers, case managers, therapists, and any other professionals caring for older adults. Also open to researchers who are advancing knowledge in the field of aging.

SELECTION CRITERIA

The following criteria is used in selecting from the nominees:

- Demonstration of exemplary interprofessional geriatric practice or education
- Impact in the community and/or place of employment related to the nominee's activities
- Scope or length of service
- Contribution to knowledge to the field of aging research
